- Parents will schedule conferences with individual teachers using Conference Manager. Please visit <https://athenshs.schoolsoft.com/> starting February 22nd to sign up for your appointment(s). If this is your first time visiting the site, click "REGISTER NOW" to create an account. Once registered, you can select the teachers you'd like to meet. If you've attended previous conferences, simply log in and select your teachers.
- If you are unable to schedule an appointment for conferences, please note that teachers are available to communicate via Schoology, email, or phone regarding your student's progress in class.

Noteworthy Information:

- Each conference is scheduled for five minutes to allow for teachers to see as many parents as possible. We kindly ask for your cooperation in respecting the allotted time to ensure the smooth running of the event and to avoid any delays for other participants.
- Counselors and social workers will be available for individual sign-up conferences.
- When registering through Conference Manager, please provide your most accessible phone number. On the evening of conferences, a link containing the teachers' Microsoft Teams link will be sent to you. Clicking the link will allow you to enter the conference session. In case of any technology issues, the teacher will call the phone number provided instead of using Microsoft Teams.

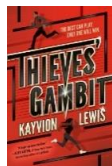
Swimming in a Sea of Stars by Julie Wright (realistic fiction)

A single kindness can save a life. After surviving a suicide attempt, Addison returns to school where her life intersects with four other students, each of whom are also struggling with their own issues. This powerful story reminds us that we are all dealing with thoughts that we don't always share....but maybe we should.



Not Here to Stay Friends by Kaitlyn Hill (realistic fiction)

Two childhood best friends reunite in L.A. the summer before senior year--but when one of them ends up starring on a reality dating show, their feelings for each other get complicated.



Thieves' Gambit by Kayvion Lewis (suspense)

Seventeen-year-old Ross Quest enters the Thieves' Gambit, a competition consisting of dangerous, international heists, in order to save her mother's life.



Drowning by T.J. Newman (suspense)

When Flight 1421 crashes into the ocean six minutes after take-off, the surviving passengers believe they are the lucky ones until the plane starts to sink to the ocean floor, trapping them inside, and they must wait to be rescued as both air and time run out.



Monstrous by Sarah Myer (graphic novel memoir)

Bullied by her classmates, Sarah, a Korean American girl growing up in a rural community with few Asian neighbors, channels her rage into her art and cosplay until it threatens to explode.



Accountable by Dashka Slater (non-fiction)

When a high school student started a private Instagram account that used racist and sexist memes to make his friends laugh, he thought of it as "edgy" humor. Then a few other people found out, and pretty soon, everyone knew. No one was safe from the repercussions of the account's discovery: not the girls targeted by the posts. Not the boy who created the account. Not the group of kids who followed it. What does it mean to be held accountable for harm that takes place behind a screen?



The Impossible Escape by Steve Sheinkin (non-fiction)

A true story of two Jewish teenagers racing against time during the Holocaust--one in hiding in Hungary, and the other in Auschwitz, plotting escape. This is the story of one of history's most famous whistleblowers, and how his death-defying escape helped save over 100,000 lives.

But when sabotage causes her to fail her qualifying trial, she is banished to the Border Wall...until the kidnapping of the prince gives her one last chance to reclaim her rightful position of power.



A Door in the Dark by Scott Reintgen (fantasy)

Snatched from the safety of Balmerick University's campus and set down in the middle of nowhere, Ren Monroe guides the remaining wizardry students through the punishing wilderness with limited magical resources, stumbling upon tangled secrets while being stalked by something in the dark woods.



Mid-Year Transcripts - All seniors who need to send a mid-year and final transcript MUST use Parchment, even if you used Common App for your regular applications.

Directions for sending transcripts to Common App from Parchment are below:

Log in to your Parchment account at www.parchment.com. Next, in the search box, type "Common Application" and search. Common Application will come up on a list, select it and continue. On the next screen, you will enter your Common App ID #.

Verify that the information is correct: your name and your counselor's name. It will list the colleges that you have selected on your Common Application. Click the Save and Continue button to move on (or Save & Add Another for additional destinations.) and confirm to send.

For **ALL** Mid-Year Transcript requests - Please use the "Hold for Grades" option. We will release your transcript when it has been updated with Semester 1 grades.

AP Registration and Payment for 2nd Semester Courses ONLY: You must register with the join code provided by your AP Teacher for **any 2nd Semester course you are enrolled in**. You will need to **pay for your exam(s) through School Pay**. The **cost of each AP exam is \$100**. If you register for an exam and do not pay by March 4th, your exam will not be ordered. If you pay and do not register, you will be refunded on March 4th. CollegeBoard is only accepting payment and registration for 2nd semester courses.

Juniors As juniors schedule for senior classes, it is important for them to select courses that will be challenging for them as they continue to prepare them for their future academic and vocational endeavors.

The College Board, www.collegeboard.org is an excellent resource for students searching for colleges or universities which are a good fit. The information provided includes selectivity, location, major and minor areas of study, and more.

College applications, which are typically completed by students between August 1st and November 1st of their senior year, usually require students to provide a copy of their senior year schedule. It is the student's responsibility to make colleges aware of ANY changes made to the schedule and to be sure the changes will not affect their application status or acceptance.

Sophomores and Freshmen Talk to your son/daughter about the importance of getting off to a good start each semester. All assignments need to be completed and turned in on time.

If you need extra help, ask your teacher if you can stay late or come in early to meet with them. Take advantage of free tutoring Monday-Thursday after school.

Encourage school involvement. If your son/daughter is not involved in a school activity, now is the time to join. In addition to sports, Athens has many clubs and organizations that students can participate in. For example, Project LEAD is a large community service group. There is a full list of clubs (50 different choices)
