Dear Parents and Community Members:

We are pleased to present you with the Annual Education Report (AER) which provides key information on the 2022-23 educational progress for Keith Elementary School. The AER addresses the complex reporting information required by federal and state laws. The school's report contains information about student assessment, accountability, and teacher quality. For the 2022-23 school year, schools were identified based on previous years' performance using definitions and labels as required in the Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA). A Targeted Support and Improvement (TSI) school is one that has at least one underperforming student subgroup in 2022-23. An Additional Targeted Support (ATS) school is one that has a student subgroup performing at the same level as the lowest 5% of all schools in the state in 2022-23. A Comprehensive Support and Improvement (CSI) school is one whose performance is in the lowest 5% of all schools in the state or has a graduation rate at or below 67% in 2022-23. Some schools are not identified with any of these labels. In these cases, no label is given. Our school was not given one of these labels.

Our staff remains dedicated to the design and implementation of lessons that engage students, using highly effective instructional practices that support all students. Staff engages in frequent and specific analysis of our student achievement data to inform our decisions regarding instruction as well as aid in the identification of students who are in need of specific intervention. Currently, our professional development and Professional Learning Communities (PLC) efforts are focused on these areas:

- Fostering a culture where thinking and understanding are the driving force for learning. This will be done by continuing to use Visible Thinking Routines;
- Strengthening student understanding of challenging concepts through the use of small group instruction across all content areas;



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- Strengthening student writing across the content areas with an emphasis on making a claim and supporting it with evidence and reasoning;
- Improving Tier I and Tier II of our multi-tiered system of support framework which is also a district-wide focus area;
- Increase proficiency in math problem-solving through the use of Everyday Math open response and re-engagement lessons and promoting the Standards for Mathematical Practices

Other specific strategies are further detailed in our School Improvement Plan which is available on our website.

Achievement Testing

At the elementary level, the Walled Lake Schools has a balanced assessment program to gauge students' progress and provide valuable information to teachers, parents, and students.

The i-Ready mathematics and reading diagnostics are given to students in grades K-5 three times per year. This balanced assessment plan provides teachers and schools with valuable information about each child's growth and allows our professional educators to individualize instruction to meet every child's needs.

Kindergarten through third grade students who are identified as needing an Individual Reading Improvement Plan take the Developmental Reading Assessment (DRA) several times per year to determine students' progress in reading.

For grades K-5 in writing, we utilize rubrics that are aligned with our writing curriculum which assess student growth with narrative, informational, and opinion writing. Last spring all Walled Lake Consolidated Schools students in grades 3-5 participated in the M-STEP state assessments.
