The following action steps will be carried over to the new school improvement plan:

- SIP Goal #1
 - Provide high quality professional development in Universal design for learning
- Potential New Action Steps:
 - Increase professional development opportunities in inclusive practice
 - Create a master school schedule that provides time for special education teachers and general education teachers to plan for inclusion
- SIP Goal #2
 - Research and purchase high quality instructional materials for math, reading and wellness interventions
 - Use the goal setting functions in mClass and STAR Math to set benchmark and stretch goals for all students in reading and math intervention
 - Improve access to tiers 2 and 3 SEL through the use of progress monitoring and data collection
- SIP Goal #3

- Offer at least one parent workshop on a topic related to academics or behavior
- Provide opportunities for students to volunteer at various places in our community
- Provide opportunities for parent feedback throughout the year
