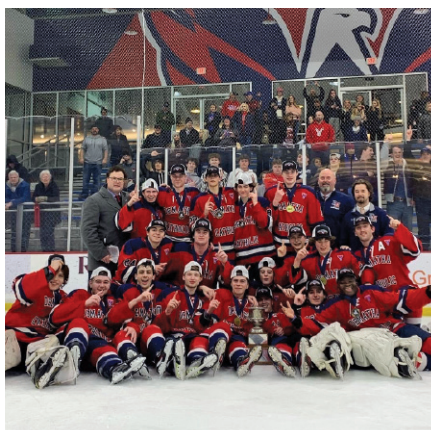

## Ed Craig '52 & the St. John de Matha Society

Mr. Craig died in 2022. This past spring, we received a very generous contribution from his estate. In speaking recently with Ed's wife, Marie, she said, "Ed told me he was thankful for all DeMatha did to make him the man that he was."

Ed played basketball and baseball at DeMatha and was a standout in baseball. He attended the University of Maryland and served two distinguished years in the U.S. Army. He was an insurance salesman in his adult life.

Both Ed and Marie have numerous DeMatha connections. Besides his work, Ed was an advocate for Johns Hopkins children's cancer research. He attended Mass regularly at St. Leo the Great in Baltimore. "Ed truly believed that DeMatha was



instrumental in his faith formation, and he believed it was important to attend Mass," Marie said.

In 1997, the school established the St. John de Matha Society to recognize those who have put DeMatha in their estate plans. We understand that not everyone wants to disclose that type of information publicly. But, as Mr. Craig's contribution clearly shows, making a bequest can be a way for a donor to make a gift, sometimes substantial, that he or she was (perhaps) unable to make when they were living.

# FATHER DAMIAN

## 50 Years at DeMatha, He Still Loves Teaching

Father Damian Anuszewski is known to thousands of DeMatha graduates as a theology, business and, for the veteran alumni, typing teacher. He also served as rector for about 13 months.

“My love is being in the classroom,” Fr. Damian said. “I enjoy mixing with the students, the young men who walk these halls, not being behind a desk.”

Fr. Damian is in his 50th year at DeMatha, although not consecutively. After the 2024-25 school year, he hopes to explore other ministry options at DeMatha.

“I’ve been blessed,” he said. “Over these past 50 years, I have worked with Trinitarians and lay men and women who are dedicated to the mission of DeMatha. I have been very privileged to be a part of that.”

From 1968-75, Fr. Damian was here as Brother Damian. He then left for four years to get his theology degree from St. Mary’s Seminary and University in Baltimore. He returned as a priest in 1979 and remained here for six years. In 1985-86, at the request of Trinitarian leadership, he served at a parish in Perth Amboy, N.J.

Fr. Damian came back to reside at the DeMatha Monastery, now St. John DeMatha Hall, in 1986 to finish his master of divinity degree from Washington Theological Union. He returned to the classroom in 1987 and has been here ever since.

“A DeMatha education is defined by relationships,” Principal Dr. Dan McMahon ’76 said. “Fr. Damian has built relationships with so many young men over the years that he is asked to officiate at weddings, perform baptisms and preside at funerals. He is with alums and their families in times of joy, in times of welcoming and in times of grieving.

“Perhaps no person at DeMatha is a better example of accompanying people on their journey.”

Fr. Damian joined the Trinitarian Order after graduating from Patterson High School in Baltimore in 1964. When he arrived at DeMatha in 1968, he was one of 13 Trinitarians living and working here. John Moylan was in his first year as principal. In addition to



teaching, Fr. Damian also worked in the dean’s office and eventually took over the bookstore.

DeMatha had about 450 students in 1968. Fr. Damian said even then he could sense the dedication and relationship-building among faculty and students.

One of the biggest changes he has seen is in technology. He remembers using transparencies until learning PowerPoint in 2005. When Dr. McMahon introduced cyber day – at-home learning – Fr. Damian didn’t see a reason for it.

“But when the pandemic struck [in 2020-21], and we had all-remote learning, we were so well prepared,” he said. “I credit Dr. McMahon for that.”

Fr. Damian also serves DeMatha as the longtime moderator of the Senior Boosters and the football and basketball teams.

“I have enjoyed traveling with the teams over the years,” he said. “For example, it was a great experience with our basketball team to travel and play in Utah, California, North and South Carolina, France and Japan. The players grew in their friendships and brotherhood and, in a way, became a small family within the DeMatha family.”

Fr. Damian, one of 77 Trinitarians who have worked at DeMatha, knew many of the school’s 1946 founders. “It’s a privilege following in their footsteps,” he said. “It’s a privilege working in a ministry of Catholic education that we founded.

“As I look back to these 50 years of ministry, I can say with deep emotion and great pride: ‘DeMatha Today! DeMatha Forever!’”

# Michael K. Jones '91 Court

## DeMatha Unveils Michael K. Jones '91 Court

**M**ike Jones '91 first etched his name into the DeMatha basketball record book. Now the school is honoring him by naming the floor in the Lt. (SEAL) Brendan Looney '99 Convocation Center the "Michael K. Jones '91 Court."

The announcement was made during a ceremony at the Morgan and Kathy Wootten Gymnasium on Aug. 13. Dozens of former players, managers, coaches and friends attended. **The official dedication will be prior to the Dec. 15 game against Good Counsel.**

"Mike Jones' gifts to DeMatha as a student-athlete, counselor, admissions director, teacher and coach are extraordinary," DeMatha President Father James Day said. "And in those roles, he changed the trajectory of the lives of countless people on the court and in the classroom."

Jerami Grant '12, a star for the Portland Trail Blazers, was among those attending. He committed to donating \$250,000 across five years to the Stags' basketball program. He still speaks highly of his prep coach.

"He was always here for us," Grant said. "He mentored us and helped us to grow into the men we are today. So, it means a lot to see him be honored in this way."

Jones, who joined Morgan Wootten's staff as an assistant coach in 1998, succeeded his mentor as interim head coach just before the start of the 2002-03 season. Jones led the Stags to eight Washington Catholic Athletic Conference championships, seven No. 1 final rankings and a 2006 national title.

After an initial 15-17 season, the Stags improved to 19-11. By year three they were 29-2, and The Washington Post named Jones Coach of the Year. He produced his highest winning percentage (.971) in 2005-06 by leading DeMatha to a record of 34-1. Between 2004 and 2007, the Stags were 95-9 (.913) and won three straight WCAC titles. They three-peated again in 2008-11.

"The leadership of this school has always talked about



building and creating not just the athlete, but the young man," Jones said during his appreciation speech. "And I know that every single day, especially when we lost, I was able to look at that and remind myself what the ultimate goal actually was."

In addition to Grant, Jones coached several other NBA players, including Jerian Grant '10, Quinn Cook, Victor Oladipo '10, Markelle Fultz '16, Nate Darling '16 and Jordan Hawkins '21. Fultz was the top overall pick of the 2017 NBA Draft. One of his teammates, Chase Young '17, was the No. 2 pick of the 2020 NFL Draft.

Hunter Dickinson '20, who's now at Kansas, will likely join the NBA ranks. He credits Jones for much of his development.

"He took me as a young boy coming into ninth grade and I came out, I feel like, as a young man very prepared not just for basketball but for life," Dickinson said. "I'm very thankful for him. He's really done a lot for me."

Jones punctuated his DeMatha tenure in 2021 with 511 career victories. He is now an assistant coach at the University of Maryland.

"It is such an honor to stand here today and have this happen, but ultimately the we in me is happy that I'm able to share this with you all," the 2017 DeMatha Hall of Fame inductee said. "Thank you all so much."

## Goodbye to Longtime Finance Director Anne Metz

**A**nne Metz, our longtime director of finance, left DeMatha at the end of September when she accepted the position of head of finance and operations at the Connelly School of the Holy Child in Potomac, Md.

We asked Anne about any parting commentary she may have about DeMatha. “I don’t think people understand just how rigorous the academic program is here,” she said. “I

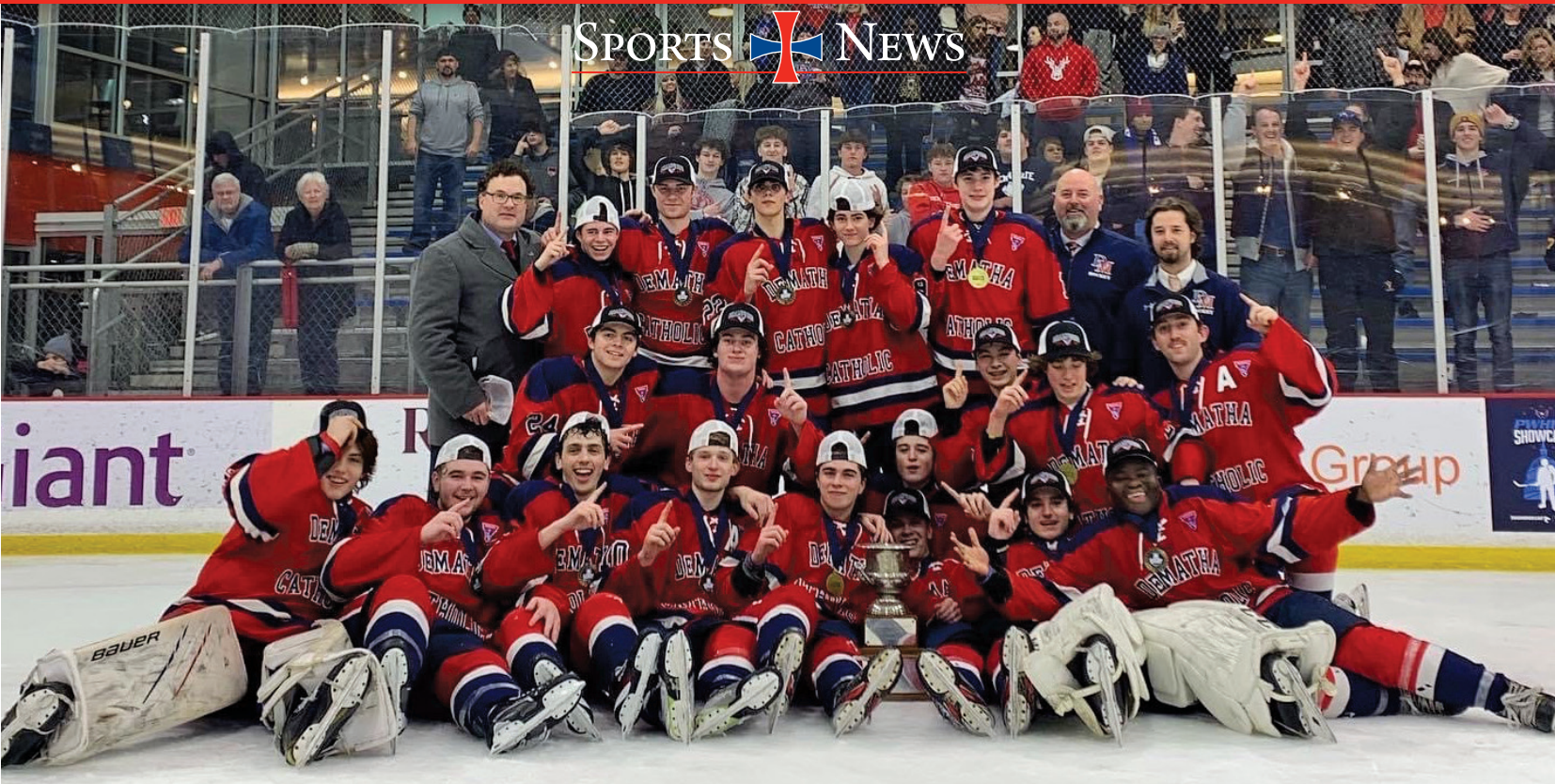
witnessed it firsthand as a parent but have seen it in other ways as well. I know of families who have transferred in who have been surprised at the school’s academic offerings.”

## DEMATHA HOCKEY TEAM WINS 11TH STATE CHAMPIONSHIP

*Editor's Note: We were remiss in not including this in our summer issue.*

The 2022-23 DeMatha prep hockey team picked a good time to get hot.

After slogging through the regular season with a 7-15-3 record, the Stags entered the Mid-Atlantic Prep Hockey League (MAPHL) Tournament seeded eighth. They went on to win four-straight games, all against teams they had not beaten in the regular season.

When the ice flakes had settled, DeMatha was hoisting the state championship trophy for the 11th time and first since 2008.

"Those four playoff games were so much fun because you could see the win coming," Coach Tony MacAulay said. "At the beginning of the run, we said, 'it's not gonna be easy being the eighth seed.' Guys were concerned and playing with a little bit of a chip on their shoulder because we knew we could have been higher in the standings."

The Stags began their ascent by downing St. Albans, 2-0. They then fell behind Gonzaga, 1-0, before unleashing a five-goal onslaught and winning 6-2.

DeMatha, which had lost to St. John's in the Washington Catholic Athletic Conference Tournament, blanked the Cadets, 4-0. This set the Stags up for the title with Georgetown Prep at the Washington Capitals' practice rink in Arlington, Va.

DeMatha struck first in the second period when Christian Gamez took a pass from Ryan Trindade and scored from the blue line. Twenty-four seconds after the Little Hoyas tied it, Trindade tallied on a wraparound. Just 20 seconds later, Jeremy Wilson scored to put the Stags up 3-1 en route to a 4-2 victory.

Trindade and Wilson, DeMatha's leading scorers a year ago, have both graduated, as has defensemen Kaleb MacAulay (Tony's son) and Alex Sandel. Wilson is playing for Towson and Sandel for Maryland.

MacAulay was named first-team All-Met and is now playing junior "A" hockey for the Brockville Braves in Ontario, Canada. Will Schine is a goalie for the elite Bridgewater (Mass.) Bandits.

MacAulay, entering his 22nd season with the Stags in 2023-24, said last year was only the second time in his tenure that DeMatha finished out of the top three prior to the state playoffs.

"We knew we were gonna be OK, but it took a while for us to achieve that discipline of playing our system and playing to our strengths," said MacAulay, who was named WCAC Coach of the Year.

DeMatha's top hockey team, which finished 11-15-3, is its prep squad. The second level is varsity. The MAPHL's top division is made up of 11 teams from the WCAC, the Interstate Athletic Conference and the Maryland Interscholastic Athletic Association.

The Stags also compete in the WCAC with Gonzaga, St. John's and O'Connell. The league didn't start sponsoring hockey until 2016-17. DeMatha won the first four titles.

The Stags take three big trips each year, to Jamestown, N.Y., Woonsocket, R.I., and Notre Dame. They will do so with a much-younger team this season. Top players include, among others, James Mullins, Jack Guy, Anthony Tallant, Kalen Wells, Nick Church, Mikey Griffiths, Jack Emling and Reagan Hirabayashi.

"We'll be young overall, but I don't see that as a bad thing," said MacAulay, whose career record of 427-254-57 (.617) includes six state championships.

Losing in the WCACs helped spur DeMatha to the MAPHL crown. "Our guys said, 'now we have another chance,'" MacAulay said. "We knew we had to play our best at the right time, and we certainly did."



## NOVICE DEMATHA RUNNER WINS WCAC CROSS COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIP

DeMatha senior Chase Lopez went from having never competed in cross country to winning the 2023 Washington Catholic Athletic Conference individual championship. He is the first Stag in 14 years to win the prestigious race.

On Oct. 28, Lopez ran the 3.1-mile (5K) course at Kenilworth Park in Northeast Washington in 16:07 to capture the WCAC title. He held off Gonzaga junior William Buckley by two seconds. Anthony Sarro, Buckley's sophomore teammate, was third (16:26).

"It certainly takes a level of natural talent to win the championship," DeMatha cross country coach Cory Puffett '10 said, "but it was difficult when you have so many really strong runners in the conference. This is one of the strongest years the WCAC has had in terms of really elite individual athletes.

"Particularly Sarro and Buckley – they have been excellent all year. So, for Chase to do what he did, this year of all years, is remarkable. It definitely shows the level of dedication he had throughout the season."

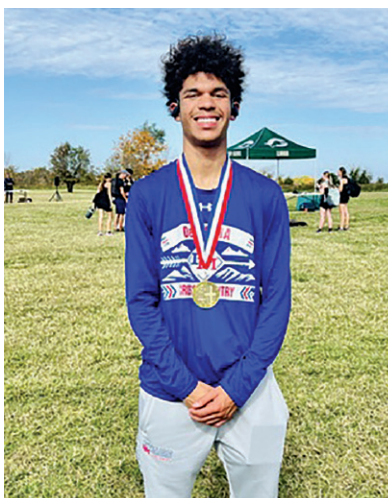
Gonzaga won the team championship (31 points). The Heights was second (68) and the Stags third (99).

Lopez came to DeMatha as a soccer player and played a year on the freshman team and two on JV. He joined Buddy Crutchfield's indoor track team in January, primarily to improve his speed and stamina for soccer. He said that Stags distance coach Harry Allen recognized his running ability.

"It was kind of weird because as soon as I joined track, [Allen] said, 'you're really good at track. I can get you to where you need to be to run in college,'" Lopez said. "He was like, 'I don't recommend you do soccer unless you really want to.'"

Lopez continued with DeMatha's outdoor track team and ran in 800-, 1600- and 3,200-meter races. In August, instead of continuing his soccer career, he joined the cross country team.

In Puffett, Lopez benefitted by learning from the most accomplished cross country athlete in school history. In 2022, Puffett guided the Stags to the WCAC championship and was elected to the DeMatha Hall of Fame.



"He really pushed me," Lopez said. "His practices started off easy and had me thinking like this could be a breeze. And then every week it got more challenging. Instead of doing a 30-minute run, we're hopping up to a good 80-minute run at moderate pace. And I'm like, OK, I've got to take this seriously.

"That's when I knew it was time to grind so I could see more success in track season. I felt like it was going to prepare me for track, but it actually prepared me for the WCAC championships. And that's how I was able to win it."

Success came gradually for Lopez. In his first race, Sept. 2 in Leesburg, Va., he finished 28th in 18:24.8. On Sept. 30, he ran a team-best 16:40.

Two weeks later, he and senior Sayid Shakur raced in the MileStat.com XC Invitational. Competing against some of the top runners on the East Coast, they both set personal records: Lopez in 15:51, Shakur in 16:03.

Gonzaga's Sarro was eight seconds faster than Lopez; Buckley was a second better.

At the WCAC Championships, Lopez and Buckley eventually broke away from the pack. With approximately 400 meters to go, Puffett told Lopez that he could outsprint Buckley to the finish, thinking he would make his kick with about 100 meters remaining. Instead, Lopez took off right away en route to victory.

Lopez is planning to run cross country in college. The primary schools he's considering are Indiana Tech, Howard, Marymount, Bowie State and Fairleigh-Dickinson. On Nov. 19, he and Shakur competed in the Nike Cross Regionals Southeast.

"I feel like there's so much more I can accomplish in college because I'm all new to this," Lopez said. "So, give me another year and my times will drop even more."
