Richard spoke about Council Responsibilities. The council needs to make recommendations on School & Programs, School LAND Trust, and Student Safety with Technology  
The Trust Land Plan is aligned with school and district goals.

Our Goals this year are to;

Increase Reading Proficiency in Kindergarten to %80

Increase 1st-5th Reading Proficiency to %55

Measured with Acadience

Increase Kindergarten Math Proficiency to %75

Increase 1st - 5th Math Proficiency to %55

We are currently at %36 in kindergarten and %42 in 1st-5th grade

Last year we started at %27 in Kindergarten Reading Proficiency and made it to %86. 1st-5th grade started at %38 and made it to %47

In Math Proficiency Kindergarten started at %27 and made it to %63. 1st and 5th grade started at %18 and made it to %53
