If an interpreter is needed for comments, they will be translated to English and the time limit shall be six (6) minutes. The Board may limit the total time for public comment to a reasonable time. Under the Ralph M. Brown Act, the Board is unable to respond to any individual comments or questions regarding items not on the agenda; however, the Board listens carefully to, and reads, all public comments and appreciates community input and participation. The Board reserves the right to mute or remove a participant from the meeting if the participant unreasonably disrupts the Board meeting.

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Access to Board Materials: A copy of the written materials, which will be submitted to the Board, may be reviewed by any interested persons on the California Montessori Project's website along with this agenda, following the posting of the agenda at least 72 hours in advance of this meeting.

- Employee Retention Tax Credit Engagement Letter Approval** (Attachment A1)
 - Comment:** The Employee Retention Tax Credit was created by the CARES Act in March 2020 to encourage businesses and non-profits to retain employees. When filed on a refund basis, as would be the case here, a qualifying organization receives direct payments for approved amounts that are deemed uncategorized and unrestricted for accounting purposes. CMP's potential possible financial gain by participating in the tax credit is approximately \$4,377,101.
 - Recommendation:** The Board is requested to approve the Employee Retention Tax Credit Engagement Letter.
