

Dorchester Two Educational Foundation imagine the possibilities

DDTwo is the only Lowcountry district with a Foundation. The Dorchester Two Educational Foundation has awarded more than \$1.7M to directly enrich DDTwo teachers, students, and community through innovative programs and supports.



Infusing STEAM in classrooms serving students with special needs, the Foundation invested \$160,000 for hydroponic gardens at all DDTwo schools. Featured at the National Association of Education Foundations National Conference, this program is being replicated in districts nationwide.

To support DDTwo's security efforts, the Foundation

purchased a gun-detection K-9, Chester, to strengthen safety at schools and district events.
