## Descriptive Statistical Report for Staff of Los Gatos High School and Fisher Middle School (8<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade)

**Note:** The Margin of Error (MOE) is calculated based on the population and sample size. The overall survey MOE tells us how much the survey results might vary from the real responses of the entire group being studied. It is like a safety zone around each survey result. We used a 95% confidence level for this survey which resulted in a 8% MOE for the total. To illustrate what this means, suppose 60% of *surveyed* Los Gatos school staff answered “yes” on a certain survey question. We can then say that we are 95% confident that between 56% and 64% of *all* Los Gatos school staff would answer “yes” on that survey question.
