#### INDOOR TRACK AND FIELD (BOYS RESULTS) STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

As a team the boys finished 2nd overall and set a new State Record:

- 1600M Arthur Langley placed 1st and set a new personal and state record (4:18:16)
- 3200M Arthur Langely placed 2nd (9:27:69)
- 4X800 (Sebastian Guerrero, Arthur Langley, Eli McMillan, and Fletcher Hughey) placed 1st (8:22:11)
- 800M Sebastian Guerrero placed 2nd (1:59:13)
- 400M Sebastian Guerrero placed 3rd (50.95)
- 60M Hurdles Carson McFadden placed 2nd (8.69)
- High Jump Carson McFadden placed 3rd (6' 0")
- 4X400 (Sebastian Guerrero, Braydon Lowery, Eli McMillan, and Fletcher Hughey) placed 4th (3:36:68)



#### INDOOR TRACK AND FIELD (GIRLS RESULTS) STATE CHAMPIONSHIPS

As a team the girls finished 7th overall and had some outstanding performances to wrap up the season:

- Girls 4X800M (Amelia Leath, Zuzu Dillard, Lydia Hamilton, and Claire Humphrey) 2nd overall with a season best time of 10:12
- Long Jump Lacy Jackson jumped a personal record of 16 feet
- Pole Vault Katie Marie Everett placed 5th overall with a vault of 9'
- Girls 4X400M (Jaleah Rucker, Mallory Ogle, Lydia Hamilton, and Lacy Jackson) placed 5th overall
- Pentathlon Kaitlin Gilchrist broke the school record
- Triple Jump Kaitlin Gilchrist had a season best jump
- 800M Claire Humphrey placed 4th overall with a new personal record of 2:27.01
