



NOTIFICATION OF INTENT TO HOMESCHOOL

Intervention Services

Notice of intent to provide a homeschool (home-based) education program is required each school year. Notification must be submitted a minimum of 14 days prior to beginning a homeschool program. Students will not be withdrawn from school to enroll in homeschooling until homeschool eligibility is confirmed by the District's Department of Intervention Services.

A Notification of Intent to Homeschool form should be submitted annually for each child being homeschooled. Return to:

Notifications: In compliance with the Colorado Revised Statute (22-33-104.5)(3)(g), records of each child participating in a Home-Based Educational Program will be maintained on a permanent basis by the parent or guardian supervising the program. The child(ren) is required to be evaluated using a standardized achievement test when he/she reaches the equivalent ages of grades **three, five, seven, nine and eleven**. If the child falls below the thirteenth percentile on a standardized test, he/she may be denied homeschool status, in which case the parent may request an opportunity for the student to be retested prior to enrolling in school.

The District does not provide special education services to students who withdraw from school to participate in homeschooling, nor is a change of placement staffing required for such cases.
