



CHILD FIND - A SEARCH FOR ALL CHILDREN WITH DISABILITIES

Every school district has the responsibility of seeking out and identifying children in need of special education services. Although school-age children are identified through each building's intervention assistance team and referral process, parents of children not yet enrolled, who reside within the Tri-Valley Local Schools boundaries, may not be aware that services are available.

What does a disability mean:

For ages birth to 3: an established condition known to result in delay or a developmental delay.

For ages 3-5: a documented deficit in one or more of the following developmental areas:

communication vision
hearing motor skills
self-help skills cognitive skills
social/emotional/behavioral functioning

For ages 5-21: identification of one of more of the following conditions

autism

hearing impairment including deafness Intellectual disability multiple disabilities orthopedic impairment other health impairment emotional disturbance specific learning disabilities speech or language impairment traumatic brain injury visual impairment including blindness
