FS2 Performing Arts: Term 2A (Animals)

The students will be learning and developing a variety of music skills

- Listening Music Appreciation.
- Theory The Elements of Music Pulse, Rhythm and
- Dynamics.
- Performing Vocal Training and Percussion Instruments
 Dance and Movement, including balance.

Listen and Appraise – the students will encounter a wide range of musical genres and styles and start to identify the sounds of different musical instruments.

The students will have a chance to learn about "Peter and the Wolf Characters and Instruments", this will give them a new perspective about sounds and music.

Theory – students will identify percussion instruments and body percussion to explore rhythm patterns, using 'call and response'.

Performing – as part of the 'Animals' topic, students will be learning the song "Horsey Horsey Don't You Stop". Also the students will explore more animals sounds through "The Animals song".

Dance and Movement – developing their gross motor skills, children will be asked to respond to

different types of music using their bodies; they will copy the teacher and be encouraged to devise their own physical response to the music.
