

CORVALLIS STEAM MAGNET MIDDLE SCHOOL UNIFORM/DRESS POLICY

Corvallis Middle School strongly believes that proper uniform attire contributes to the success of all students by promoting safety, a sense of pride and distinction. It is expected that all students at Corvallis maintain a neat, clean, and appropriate appearance. A student's dress and general appearance should not draw undue attention, nor interfere with the learning process or the discipline in the school.

| Clothing Items | Colors | Details |
|---|-------------------------------|---|
| Polo Shirt | Burgundy | Must be a burgundy polo shirt with or without the school logo. |
| Pants, Shorts, Skirts, Skorts, Nylon/Khaki Fitted Joggers | Blue, black, tan, gray, khaki | Sweats, leggings, and pants with holes or tears located between the knee and waist are not allowed. If there are tears, then students need to have leggings underneath their pants. |
| Closed Toe Shoes | Any Color | Flip-flops, slippers, Crocs, shower shoes, and open-toe sandals are not allowed. Appropriate footwear should be worn at all times. |
| Hats | Any color | No professional sports team logos allowed, with the exception of spirit days. Hats/beanies with school affiliated, local youth sports, and college logos are allowed. Hats and beanies must be removed during instructional time. |

Please note the following items:

- No second shirt may be worn over the polo shirt.
- Jewelry that may pose a safety concern on campus is not allowed. No jewelry may be worn during PE.
- Students may not wear PE clothes outside of PE.
- No student shall wear articles of clothing, jewelry, or accessories, which in the opinion of school administration, pose a threat to the physical well-being and safety of the student or others.

The following items are prohibited on campus, school activities, and all athletic events.

- Clothing must be of appropriate size and proportionate per individual (skirt, skort, or shorts must be no more than one inch below the knee or not shorter than mid-thigh length). Pants must fit and be worn at waist, they may not be taken in, cut off, stapled, or taped. Pants must not sag. No ProClub shorts or sweats allowed.
- All belts must be worn with the belt loop.
- Plain white or black t-shirts are not allowed.
- No drawing/writing on skin allowed.
- All tops must meet the top of the student's pants, shorts, or skirt when hands are raised. Crop tops are not allowed.
- High knee socks or socks touching the bottom of the leg of shorts are not allowed. No fishnets stockings allowed.
- Sunglasses are not to be worn during instructional time.
- Hoods of hoodies are not to be worn in class.

Any clothing or school materials, including backpacks, that have pre-printed or handwritten inappropriate/offensive language, sayings, drawings, or advertising that reference alcohol, drugs, sexually explicit material, gang activity (including tagging), violence, or any other illegal material are not permitted on campus.

1st Violation- Log of incident, verbal warning & opportunity to change

2nd Violation- Log of incident, parent call & opportunity to change

Ongoing Violations- Log of incident, parent call & progressive school discipline will be assigned by school administration.
