- a. Review the SPSA and budget for 2021-2022 ~ Goals are focused on academic and social-emotional support for students. Due to COVID pandemic and Distance Learning, many students will have substantial learning loss; equity and access is important for ALL students. We will provide systemic interventions within our Advisory classes to address academics and social emotional support. Title I funding will be utilized to ensure we have the programs to support our students. PLTW is a program that is available to ALL students. The number of the sections have been increased to be available to ALL students to provide access that will show the application from their core classes. Intervention and PLTW are programs that go beyond their core classes. Title I will support these systemic programs/electives to see the applications of core classes. The preliminary budget is \$319, 685 for Title I and \$86,316 for LCFF; these programs will be supported by these funds. ~ No questions.
