- VII. **New Business: Legal Requirements:**
 - a. Review the First Diagnostic iReady Data ~ Diagnostic will give the teacher information and data as to students strengths and weaknesses; this helps teachers guide instruction. Participation data for ELA: 6th gr ~ 85%, 7th gr 63%, 8th gr 84% completed. Student participation needs to increase to 90% or above for diagnostic #2 (which will be in Dec/Jan). Participation data for Math: 6th gr ~ 91% 7th gr ~ 83%, 8th gr ~ 92%. Adam shared the importance of iReady being shared with parents (dialer and website/schoology). Results for both ELA / Math iReady data was shared with the committee. April asked about parents receiving the iReady results; teachers can give this to parents. No questions at this time.
 - b. The Road to Reclassification: ELPAC Prep Classes ~ In Dec, Jan & Feb is when we prepare for the ELPAC (test all EL learners take); they need a "4" for reclassification. Students that scored a 1, 2, or low 3, have the opportunity to take an ELPAC prep class during their elective. This prepares them for the ELPAC in Feb. A teacher from each grade level will teach this prep class (pay comes from Title I). No questions at this time.
 - c. 2021-2022 Master Schedule and Projected Enrollment ~ Dec. 1, 2020 begins Open Enrollment; Ends Jan. 31, 2021. If parents do not do Open Enrollment, it will be difficult for them to choose a school other than their homeschool. Los Alisos offers the most options in regards to programs: Spanish (if students complete Spanish 1 A & B, they get 1 yr credit in high school; Spanish 2 will get them 2 yrs of Spanish for high school) AVID, Dual Immersion (only middle school to offer this, Bi-literacy seal can be earned with dual immersion), PLTW (16 different courses), VAPA (music, band & orchestra). No questions at this time.

- a. ELAC/DELAC ~ Working on staying connected with families; sharing the apps with the families (Notability, PowerSchool, Schoology). ELAC/Coffee with Counselors is 11/18/2020 @ 11:30am. Over 400 food baskets will be distributed on 11/18/2020 from 3-4:30pm. DELAC ~ Parent survey for returning to school. Tutoring offered for grades 4 - 12; Khan academy; parent classes on the district website. Khan Academy and Tutor.com is accessible 24/7. No questions at this time.
- b. AVID ~ Mrs. Theeck attended AVID training; strategies to support the students virtually. No questions at this time.
- c. Magnet ~ Mr. Gonzales shared strategies used for doing more visual type projects (Green Architecture), more digital work is being done. Mr. Gonzales is coordinating with the district to get supplies for a building project they typically do. No questions at this time.
