- VII. **New Business: Legal Requirements:**
 - a. EL Parent Meeting—The Road to Reclassification ~ Dr. Salehi reviewed the criteria for reclassification; reclassification criteria was reviewed with parents at the ELAC meeting as well; additional parent meetings will be held for parent participation. Dr. Salehi shared the importance of getting students reclassified before entering high school. We have approximately 205 EL students this year (18% of LAMS population).

 - b. R-FEP Follow-up Monitoring Meetings ~ Dr. Salehi shared that once students are reclassified, we will monitor their progress and schedule follow up meetings with parents in Fall and Spring to ensure students are making satisfactory progress in their classes.

 - c. Activities to Build Parent Capacity ~ Parent involvement is important to academic and social emotional success of the students. At Los Alisos we embrace parent and family involvement. Parent involvements include: monthly ELAC meeting, monthly Coffee with the Counselors, parenting classes, arts & crafts classes, celebrating cultural events such as Hispanic Heritage month, Dia de Muertos, etc. Dr. Salehi asked for input and feedback to increase building parent capacity. Mrs. Williams asked about the PTSA and would like to be a part of PTSA. Mrs. Magana shared that ELAC/PTSA are working together to plan events and increase parent involvement.

SSC did not have any other questions.

- d. Importance of Attendance ~ Dr. Salehi shared that we need school and parents to work as a team to support their student, to attend class daily and on time. If students are missing zoom, they are missing instructional time. Attendance counts during distance learning. SART's (school site intervention) and SARB's (district level intervention that includes Student and Family Services as well as a district attorney) will be starting soon.
