SSC Meeting Minutes

Date: November 21, 2019

- I. Call the Meeting to Order at 3:16pm by Majid Salehi**
- II. Welcome & Introductions: Present: Majid Salehi, Enrique Gonzalez, Carolyn Nord, Kim Tallud, Luz Pacheco, Delayna Perez, & Lindsay Ramirez**
- III. Changes/Additions to the Agenda- None**
- IV. Secretary's Report:**
 - a. Review and approval of minutes- Kim Tallud moved, Enrique Gonzales 2nd
 - b. Review and approval of agenda- Majid Salehi moved, Kim Tallud 2nd
- V. Public Comment/Input:** Dr. Salehi shared that LAMS has been approved to move to the next steps in Schools to Watch. Parent Luz Pacheco asked what the Schools to Watch Program shows about Los Alisos. Dr. Salehi shared they will talk to students, teachers, staff, parents, and community members about 4 domains: Academic Excellence, Developmental Responsiveness, Social Equity, and Organization Structure and Processes. It a prestigious award for middle schools in California and has an opportunity to move to a nationwide recognition.

- VII. New Business: Legal Requirements:**
 - a. The Road to Reclassification: ELPAC Prep Classes- Dr. Salehi shared that after Winter Break we use Title 1 money to pay teachers at their prep to support students in an ELPAC Bootcamp. We have data to share with parents and student that shows which section(s) the student continues to need more support. Intervention counselor and teacher will share out the information in December so students can create goals and parents can support them at home. Carolyn asked about the Road to Reclassification and how we inform our parents and students. Dr. Salehi shared we use our Intervention teacher and counselor, counselor, administration and Community Liaison to support parents and students with where the child is, and what steps he or she needs to reclassify out of ELD. SSC had no questions or recommendations at this time.
 - b. 2020-2021 Master Schedule and Projected Enrollment- Dr. Salehi shared that our projection for next year is down 2 teachers. We are looking at our Master Schedule to adjust classes to see how we can support the same electives in PLTW, Spanish, and AVID. We want to provide options for students. The only class that will be added to our Master Schedule will be Spanish 2. Paula Mayes shared we are looking to move PLTW Energy and the Environment as a 7th Grade elective since it coordinates with NGSS

curriculum. Carolyn Nord shared that we should bring back art class. Dr. Salehi shared he would like to bring that back along with an additional world language. He shared the variety of electives we currently offer. Delayna Perez asked if we look at data to see if certain programs impact students. Dr. Salehi shared if a student is in intervention classes, we look to see if our programs support student learning. Dr. Salehi shared that we will bring data to share with the team along with our Intervention Teacher and Counselor to present how they use the data to support students. Paula Mayes shared that we also use D and F reports to see if a student needs more support in the core subject areas, and we adjust the student's schedule. Dr. Salehi shared that Open Enrollment will be from December 1, 2019 until January 31, 2020. SSC had no questions or recommendations at this time.

VIII. Reports:

- a. ELAC/DELAC- Dr. Salehi shared that last week at the ELAC meeting, presenters from Norwalk High School spoke about A-G requirements and expectations at high school. There were about 20-25 parents at the meeting. Luz Pacheco asked how we advertise our parent meetings. Dr. Salehi shared we promote them on Schoology, the marquee, dialers, and at other parent events. We tried to have parent meetings in the evening last year with only 5/6 parents in attendance. SSC had no questions or recommendations at this time.
- b. AVID- Carolyn shared that we now have 8 tutors to support with Tutorials. Paula shared that 6th grade AVID went on a fieldtrip to Fullerton today to visit college. SSC had no questions or recommendations at this time.
- c. Magnet- Enrique Gonzalez shared they began building their Green House. Dr. Salehi shared the Future Ready Expo will be in January. SSC had no questions or recommendations at this time.
- d. ASB- Lindsay Ramirez shared the students are planning a Spirit Week before we go on Winter Break. Delayna Perez shared that as a parent, she is happy that we allowed students to dress for Halloween. SSC had no questions or recommendations at this time.
