

**SPECIAL CALLED SCHOOL BOARD MEETINGS**

The Alexandria City School Board (Board) holds Special and Continued Meetings for purposes such as Board retreats, in-depth topics, to address short-notice action items, or when necessary. They are held at the discretion of the Board Leadership, or when a majority of Board Members submit individual requests to the Chair to call a meeting. Special Meetings may be called provided each member is notified, or a reasonable attempt has been made to notify each member.

Business that does not come within the purposes set forth in the call of the meeting is not transacted at any special meeting of the Board unless the members present unanimously agree to consider additional items of business.

Notice, reasonable under the circumstances, of Special or Continued Meetings is given contemporaneously with the notice provided to members of the Board.
