The Millbrook Central School District provides transportation services to students attending non-public schools who live within one-half (1/2) and fifteen (15) miles for children in grades K-6 and for distances between one (1) and fifteen (15) miles for children in grades 7-12. The Mileage is measured from the student's home to the school legally attending. If a student lives more than fifteen (15) miles from the non-public school of attendance, and the Millbrook Central School District transports a student who resides within the above describe transportation limits to that non-public school, the District will designate one of its public schools as a centralized pick-up point and shall provide transportation between the pick-up point and the non-public school. The District shall not be responsible for providing transportation from and to a student's home and the centralized pick-up point. If you are the parent or guardian of a pupil, and legally reside in the Millbrook Central School District and you wish transportation to and from a non-public school for the next school year, then you must complete this form by April 1st.

A separate form is required for each child.
