

**MINUTES

President Wagnon called the meeting to order at 7:02 p.m. and asked for a Roll Call.

OTHERS IN ATTENDANCE: Carrie Hruby and Joi Wills

The Board began in open session with a motion by Steve Springer to appoint the School Board President to preside over the hearings. The motion was seconded by Mary Basket. All voted aye. Motion carried.

Moved by Springer, seconded by Pulcher, to enter into Closed Session pursuant to The Open Meetings Act- 5 ILCS 120/2(c)(9) which permits a closed session to hear student disciplinary cases. All voted aye. Motion carried at 7:04 p.m.

The Board came out of Closed Session and reconvened in Open Session at 7:32 p.m.

Moved by Pulcher, seconded by Springer to find Student A violated school rules by Level IV General Act of Misconduct Gross Misconduct under circumstances so related to the school program so as to warrant discipline. All voted aye. Motion carried.


Moved by Huller, seconded by Basket to reconvene in Closed Session pursuant to The Open Meetings Act- 5 ILCS 120/2(c)(9) to determine what if any, discipline might be appropriate. All voted aye. Motion carried at 7:38 p.m.

The Board came out of Closed Session and reconvened in Open Session at 8:21 p.m.

Moved by Huller, seconded by Springer, to expel Student A for a period beginning April 5, 2016 and ending June 2017. Provided, however, the expulsion shall be stayed and held in abeyance if the student attends St. Clair Regional Safe School and complies with all relevant disciplinary and

other rules during his attendance at the Safe School. If Student A has attended the Safe School without any violation of its disciplinary rules or the disciplinary rules of O'Fallon District No. 90 through Dec. 20, 2016, with outside counseling, Student A and/or Student A's parent may request the School District administration to allow return to regular attendance in the School District. The administration's decision to allow or deny the request to return shall be within the sole discretion of the administration. If Student A is allowed to return to attendance in the School District, Student A shall comply with all disciplinary rules of the School District during the remaining term of the stayed expulsion. Any violation of a rule which could result in an out of school suspension during the term of the stayed expulsion may result in the reinstatement of the expulsion, and Student A shall not be allowed to participate in any school activities or be on school premises during the remainder of the expulsion term. Four ayes – Baskett, Pulcher, Springer and Huller. One nay – Pulcher. Motion carried 4-1.

Moved by Huller, seconded by Springer, to adjorn the meeting. All voted aye. Motion carried. Adjournment time was 8:48 p.m.
