Call to Order/Roll Call -- The meeting was called to order at 7:30 p.m.


Others in attendance: Carrie Hruby, Ed Smith, Jeff Faust and Nick Miller

Jeff Faust of Environmental Consultants presented. In 2006-07 a complaint was received from Kampmeyer School, and a full panel of water testing was completed. Since then the District has also conducted indoor air quality testing through Environmental Consultants. There is no requirement to test, but the EPA has issued a guidance document which shares the three T's: Training, Testing and Telling.


Environmental Consultants tested the first draw to replicate worst case scenario results. Those results were presented to the Board. While there are some problems, there are also solutions. For preventative maintenance, samples over the threshold of 20 ppb were taken out of service, cleaned and inspected. As a precaution, Environmental Consultants also recommends that the District look at those with half of that amount. Preventative maintenance will also help with any other contaminates (not just lead) as the same protocol is used to address other contaminants sometimes found in water sources.

This initial test is only step one of a multi-step process. After fixtures are cleaned and retested, additional, more in-depth testing can occur. Preventative maintenance should include inspection of fixtures, cleaning of aerators and cleaning of screens. Facilities Director Ed Smith explained that the District immediately took the fixtures out of service, called a plumbing company to clean and inspect them, and is ready to have them retested. Now that cleaning and inspection has been completed, retesting will be completed. Jeff Faust will bring those results to the October 18 BOE meeting.

Becky Drury made a motion to adjourn the meeting. Matt Lloyd seconded the motion. All Board members voted in favor. The meeting adjourned at 8:33 p.m.
