ORGANIZING WHICH SCHOLARSHIPS TO APPLY FOR

- All scholarship sections are listed alphabetically. To the right of each scholarship it shows if it's open to Alumni, Class of 2025 or both. Unless otherwise noted, completed scholarship applications must be submitted directly to the sponsor, by 3:30pm on Friday, March 14th, 2025. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted.

ORGANIZING MATERIALS

- Read the description for each scholarship carefully. Staple information to your application. Do not use paper clips. It is important that you follow all of the specific instructions. Many, but not all, scholarships require a transcript with the application.

TRANSCRIPT REQUEST

- Request transcripts from Mrs. Ponte in-person in the School Counseling Office. You will receive one copy of your unofficial transcript. You must make your own copies of the unofficial transcript and attach them with any other information that is requested for the various scholarships. Official transcripts are received in a sealed envelope. Transcript requests take one school day to process. Do not wait until the day of the deadline to request your transcript.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

- We have made every effort to display scholarship information accurately and completely, however, sponsoring organizations may have to change policies, awards, and/or requirements after this booklet is published. Please note, if you are a recipient of a scholarship, we will be providing your contact information to the sponsoring organization.

SCHOLARSHIP AWARD

- Unless otherwise noted, payment of scholarships will be made upon evidence of successful completion of your first semester with an official transcript from the college/university. The scholarship award information will be on the award letter presented at the Scholarship Award Night in May and will be the responsibility of the awardee to follow the instructions given on how to claim their award.

FAFSA

- A copy of your FAFSA Submission Summary eligibility overview is required for all Middleborough High School Applications.

CONNOR DONOVAN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP	2025
<p>The Connor Donovan Memorial Scholarship was created by the Connor Donovan Memorial Fund. The goal of this fund is to educate and spread awareness of the harmfulness of opioid use and more specifically the threat of fentanyl poisoning. We as a fund feel there is a connection between the mental health of adolescents and young adults and the current fentanyl epidemic. This \$2,500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating senior with the intention of pursuing an undergraduate degree in a field that helps with overall mental health: psychology, medical, social work, human resources. The recipient will receive half the scholarship towards their first semester of studies and upon maintaining a 2.5 GPA, the remaining scholarship will be given for the second semester. Applicants are asked to submit a brief essay about why/if they feel the opioid epidemic correlates with good mental health or about what they feel should be done about the current fentanyl epidemic. This scholarship will go to those in need, so please also submit a copy of FAFSA award. He was well known by his patients to be a compassionate, dedicated and knowledgeable practitioner. He was well respected by his colleagues and awarded the Mass Medical Clinician of the Year award in 2013 by both the Bristol and Plymouth County Medical Societies. He died in 2014 of glioblastoma.</p> <p>The student should exhibit high academic standing with a GPA of at least 3.0 and submit a transcript. The student should demonstrate strong moral character and citizenship evidenced through involvement in school and community activities and service groups. Supporting documentation should include a transcript, resume, recommendation, and essay. The 200-word essay should explain the student's desire to become a health care professional and how they will contribute to the well-being of others.
