APPROVE INCLEMENT WEATHER MAKEUP PROPOSAL

SITUATION

Between December 8, 2016, and January 17, 2017, Hillsboro School District students missed nine instructional days due to inclement weather, and staff have been working on a plan to recapture that time.

The District is proposing adding 7.5 makeup days to the District calendar, using the following guidelines:

- Beginning Wednesday, February 15, 2017, students will attend school during normal hours. This means there will be no late start/early release for students on Wednesdays for the remainder of the school year.
- Friday, April 14, 2017, will be a school day for all students. On the 2016-17 school calendar originally approved by the Board, April 14 was identified as a “no school” day, in order to provide elementary teachers with work time and secondary teachers with time to prepare third quarter grades.
- The end of the school year will be extended by one week for students in grades K-11. School will be in session from Monday, June 19, through Friday, June 23, 2017, with Friday being an early release day for students.
- Additionally, the end of the quarters and semester have been realigned to preserve the requirements of instructional time. The third quarter grading day has been eliminated, and the grading preparation days and teacher preparation days for fourth quarter have been moved to dates that are one week later. June 26, 2017, will be the last day for teachers.

We will communicate the decision of the Board immediately after the Board’s vote is taken, so students, staff, and families can adjust their schedules accordingly for the remainder of the school year.

RECOMMENDATION

The Superintendent recommends that the Board of Directors approve this proposal for the makeup of inclement weather days.

BOND ADVISORY COMMITTEE UPDATE

SITUATION

In August, 2016, the Hillsboro School District Board of Directors approved the formation of the Bond Advisory Committee to develop a bond package for either the November 2017 or May 2018 ballot.

This committee has now had four meetings, and has looked at several different bond funding levels and possible bond package components. On February 16, the Committee will take two or three draft bond packages to the Community for feedback. The goal of the Committee is to make a recommendation to the Superintendent this spring, for final approval by the School Board at either the April or May regular meeting.

DISCUSS TIMELINE FOR LOCAL OPTION DECISION

SITUATION

A local option levy is one of the ways school districts in Oregon can raise revenue to supplement state funding and local property taxes. Tonight's discussion will focus on the mechanics of the local option, as well as an estimate of the amount of money that might be realized by the implementation of a local option in Hillsboro.

The Board will discuss the pros and cons of moving forward with a local option, and the potential timing of this levy.
