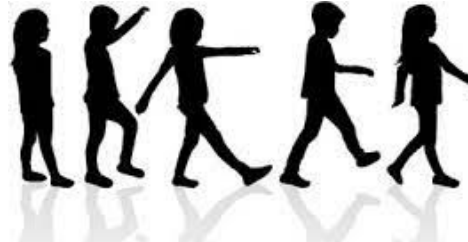

2, 3 or 4 people



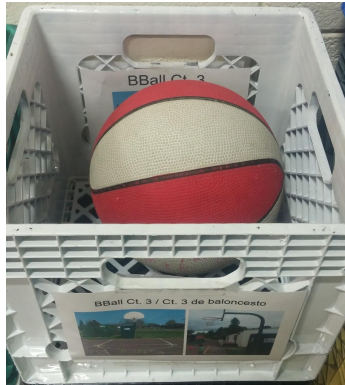
Basketball

Basketball(s) - Covered areas

Rubber balls - Wall ball, 4 square

Soccer - In the grass

Football - In the grass

Volleyball - In the grass

Electric pump available in recess closet.

Playground closet contents for later options/additions: Place backup balls on the rack there labeled for space/game.

Umbrella

One kid at a time. We don't push people.

Make sure it is clear all around.

If you can't reach, try a new activity rather than make a bark chip pile.



Glider or slider

One kid
at a
time.

No
pushing

due to
injuries.



Railroad ties or beams

Hold in the bark chips.

Not a play item to balance on.

They trip people and you can get hurt on them.



Football

Run plays.

Play 500.

No football passing on blacktop.

Please not tackling, of course!



Soccer

We only kick
soccer balls
and only in
the grass
field.



Forest

Closed for kinder.

Respect nature and animals.

Nature stays in the forest.

Don't pass the hill or the wall.

Avoid the classroom
windows.



Music

iPad & speaker

Only adults can change songs. So ask!

the balls.

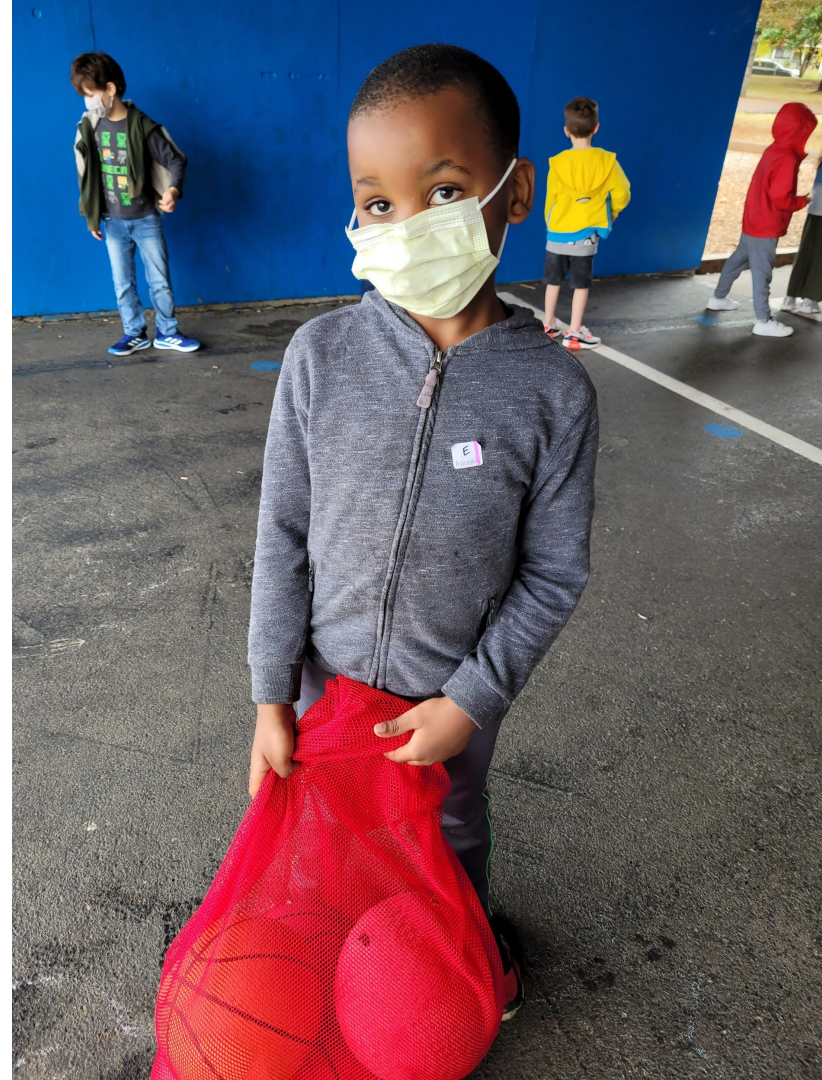

Rainy day recess considerations

- If you have a rain jacket with a hood, ask the teacher if you play on the bark chips.
- Field is closed.
- Under covered areas open for play and for those that don't have jackets where you can play basketball.
- No kid umbrellas at recess: Unsafe distance and unsafe object.



Covered Area

- Walk.
- Teachers will collect ball bags so we don't have too many out.
- No kicking balls.
- Line up in a semi circle to play "knockout."
