District News: Hillsboro School District Poised to Add \$6.2 Million to 2014-15 Budget. At their meeting on Thursday, May 8, the Hillsboro School District Budget Committee, composed of the Hillsboro School Board and an equal number of appointed citizens, unanimously approved the [2014-15 proposed budget](#), which included \$6.2 million dollars in additional funds. This will be the first school year in the past seven where money has been *added* to the budget rather than removed from it, thanks to Gain Share funds from the City of Hillsboro and Washington County, a higher appropriation from the Legislature due to last fall's Grand Bargain, a revision to the poverty calculation for schools, and updates to the 2012-13, 2013-14 and 2014-15 State School Fund estimates. The additional \$6.2 million will be used to add one of two remaining budget reduction days to the instructional calendar in 2014-15, hire additional teachers, and provide additional classified support, among other things. The Board will vote to adopt the 2014-15 budget at their meeting on Tuesday, June 10, at 7:30pm in the Administration Center Board Room.
