District News: In-District Transfer Process Begins Today for Students Entering Grades 1-12. Resident students who are currently on a one year-only transfer to another school within the District, or who would like to request a transfer to another school within the District for the 2014-15 school year, **may submit their requests between now and April 11, 2014.** Students who are being impacted by the boundary adjustment process will be receiving an individualized letter with instructions about options available to them by the end of Spring Break and will also have until April 11 to respond with their decision. Applications can be found by clicking the [Transfer Requests](#) link under either the Parents or Students drop-down menu then clicking on the In-District Transfers tab. Completed applications can be mailed, faxed, or dropped off to the District Administration Center, attention [Marleen Zytniowski](#). We hope to have decision letters mailed out to families by the end of April. The application and decision window for kindergarten transfer requests will likely be in August, however spots at our Dual Language schools may be available earlier.
