District News: Happy Anniversary, School-Based Health Center! Saturday, March 15, marks exactly one year since we held our ribbon-cutting ceremony for the school-based health center (SBHC) at Century High School. Since then, word has spread and services and usage are increasing. The center now offers primary care, mental health, and dental screening services for Hillsboro School District students and staff. They even hosted a vaccination clinic on February 19 (Exclusion Day) that served more than 60 students! The center's medical sponsor, Virginia Garcia Memorial Health Center, also earned a three-year Thriving Schools grant from Kaiser Permanente to work with the school on issues of social and emotional health, obesity prevention, and student/staff wellness. In addition, SBHC staff have been presenting to science classes at both Century and Liberty High Schools, and have begun working with Century's PE department to promote lifelong fitness. Celebrating Pi Day. Pi, symbolized by the Greek letter π , is the ratio of the circumference of a circle to its diameter. That ratio's first three digits are 3.14, hence the celebration of Pi Day on March 14th. From the ancient Egyptians and Greeks to modern-day mathematicians, no other number has captured humankind's fascination and attention quite like π —it continues infinitely without repeating digits and has been calculated, using supercomputers, to more than 1 trillion digits past the decimal. Because it represents so much mathematical fun, and because it is also the birthday of Albert Einstein—one of history's most revolutionary physicists—Pi Day has become an international holiday, with special events held around the world.
