Standards Reports Coming Home to Middle & High School Students. Oregon Legislators passed House Bill 2220 in the 2011 session. This bill requires schools to report on students' progress toward meeting grade level academic standards at least once per year, with 2013-14 being the first year of implementation for middle and high school students. This 'standards report' is different than a report card and does not replace report cards, but should hopefully provide additional insight to parents on their students' learning progress.
