**District News: Support Your Local Food Drive!** Nearly every school in our district is in the midst of holding a Food Drive for people in need in our community. Please support their efforts by dropping off your donation of non-perishable food this week! Most wanted items include: Peanut butter, juice, baking items, rice, pasta, boxed meals, canned meat, soup, beans, boxed cereal, and baby food (no formula). If you can't make it to one of our schools but still want to help, consider an online donation through the "Give a Meal" campaign. For every \$1 donated, Bank of America will give \$2 more to Feeding America food banks (you can select our local organizations—Oregon Food Bank and St. Vincent DePaul Food Recovery Network—as the recipients). Because of food banks' buying power, each dollar donated results in 9 meals distributed.
