District News: ParentVUE Comes Online in October. Hillsboro School District is transitioning to a new student information system called Synergy. The student information system is the biggest, most important database we maintain, allowing us to keep track of all pertinent data related to students. Hillsboro has planned a two-phased approach to its implementation, taking middle and high schools live in the 2013-14 school year and bringing elementary schools online in the 2014-15 school year. A secure portal called ParentVUE will be available for parents starting in October, in which they can login and view their student's data and make any necessary changes to their contact information. Schools are providing more details at their back-to-school nights on how to access the system. If you missed your child's back-to-school night, please contact the office to receive login instructions.
