**District News: State's June Budget Forecast Released.** On Thursday, May 16, State Economist Mark McMullen released Oregon's June Revenue Forecast. This forecast showed an increase of \$271.5 million in anticipated revenues for the 2013-15 biennium due to larger-than-expected tax collections and continuing improvements in Oregon's economy. Though a state budget has yet to be determined by the Legislature, it is felt that this forecast might solidify a K-12 allocation of \$6.55 billion for the biennium—a level that is \$200 million to \$400 million lower than what our District had hoped for to avoid reductions. It is still unclear what, if any, impact Governor Kitzhaber's May 14 proposal for additional PERS reforms might have on school budgets. There is still time to contact your [elected officials](#) and let them know your thoughts about school funding.
