District News: Draft 2013-14 Budget Information Available. Superintendent Scott shared 2013-14 budget information with the Board and Budget Committee during a work session on Tuesday, April 23, and at his listening session at Brown Middle School on Thursday, April 25. With the currently anticipated 2013-15 statewide K-12 funding allocation of \$6.55 billion, along with \$200 million in PERS employer rate reductions, Hillsboro is facing a gap between revenues and expenditures of approximately \$8.2 million for the 2013-14 school year. Once other necessary additions to the budget are taken into account, that gap grows to approximately \$8.576 million. The presentation shared by Superintendent Scott, as well as the draft reduction list, are available on the [Budget Matters](#) page of our website. Each principal is also holding informational meetings on the budget over the course of the next two weeks. The Board and Budget Committee will meet to officially consider the Proposed Budget for 2013-14 on Thursday, May 9, at 7:00 p.m. in the Board Room; that meeting is open to the public.
