District News: Superintendent Listening Session is Rescheduled to April 25. Please note that the Superintendent Listening Session scheduled for this Thursday, April 4, has been moved to Thursday, April 25. We wanted to push the meeting so we could share more detailed budget information with our patrons. As of press time, the Legislature had not yet approved a K-12 budget for the 2013-15 biennium; however, if the budget currently proposed by the Co-Chairs of the Joint Ways and Means Committee passes, Hillsboro will face a shortfall of more than \$8 million in the 2013-14 school year. Recommended reductions will be shared with the Board and Budget Committee at the Board work session on 4/23, then will be presented at the Listening Session on 4/25. The meeting will be held in the Brown Middle School library from 7-8:30pm; Spanish translation will be provided.
