**District News: Century School-Based Health Center Ribbon Cutting and Grand Opening.** Hillsboro’s school-based health center at Century High School is finally ready to open, so we’re celebrating the momentous occasion with a [ribbon cutting ceremony](#) this Friday, March 15, at 3:35 p.m. in the Century Student Parking Lot (1998 SE Century Boulevard). The ribbon cutting is free and open to the public—we hope you join us! The center will be open Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on school days, providing the same services you would expect from a doctor’s office: routine exams, treatment of minor illness and injury, sports physicals, immunizations, lab tests, diagnosis and treatment of acute/chronic illness, mental health counseling, and more. The center serves students from throughout the Hillsboro School District—not just those at Century High School. District staff can access the center as well. Most insurance is accepted, including the Oregon Health Plan, and a sliding fee scale is available for those without insurance.
