District News: Honoring the Legacy of Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Through Service. Rev. Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. was a pivotal figure in the Civil Rights Movement. His lectures and discussions inspired awareness and the conscience of a nation. His charismatic leadership motivated men and women in this nation and around the world. In 1994, Congress designated the Martin Luther King Jr. Federal Holiday as a national day of service. Taking place each year on the third Monday in January, MLK Day is the only federal holiday observed as a national day of service—a “day on, not a day off.” The MLK Day of Service is a part of *United We Serve*, the President’s national *Call to Service* initiative. It challenges Americans from all walks of life to work together to provide solutions to our most pressing national problems. The MLK Day of Service is intended to move us closer to Dr. King’s vision of a “Beloved Community.” On January 21, 2013, Americans of every age and background are invited to celebrate Dr. King through service projects that strengthen communities, empower individuals, bridge barriers, and create solutions.
