District News: 2011-12 School and District Report Cards now available. Each year, the Oregon Department of Education (ODE) prepares a report card for every school and district in the state. These report cards include data on student testing performance, attendance and graduation rates, staffing, and other statistical information; they also provide both state and federal ratings of the schools and districts based on formulas that take various subsets of the data into account. Per state law, school districts must ensure that all parents have access to their local school and district report cards by January 15. You can find the reports in both English and Spanish on our website under [Schools/Yearly Progress Reports](#) and on ODE's website under [Reports/Report Cards](#). Many of our schools have also posted reports on their websites. In addition, you will find a hard copy of both the District's and the school's report posted on each school's community bulletin board by the end of this week. Hard copies of the reports can be requested from your school office or from the Communications Department.
