District News: American Education Week. Hillsboro School District joins others across the nation in celebrating American Education Week November 11-17, 2012. All year long, but especially this week, we honor the men and women who have dedicated themselves to the young people of our community—from bus drivers, to office managers, to cafeteria staff, to custodians, to teachers, administrators and more—you all play a vital role in educating and supporting our students, and we thank you sincerely for all you do!

Bond Refunding to Save Taxpayers \$5.3 Million. At its October 23 meeting, the Hillsboro School Board adopted a resolution authorizing the refunding (refinancing) of our Series 2006A General Obligation bonds. These are the bonds that were sold for the capital construction that was approved by voters in November 2006 and paid for the building of Free Orchards, Rosedale, Lincoln Street and Quatama Elementary Schools as well as South Meadows Middle School, along with the expansion of the other three middle schools and a myriad of smaller projects. Refunding is only allowed if a 3% savings can be realized, and the timing of our sale on Thursday, November 8, couldn't have been better. We actually realized a 4.54% savings, which will mean a savings to our taxpayers of \$5.3 million over the next twelve years.
