District News: Integrated Pest Management. A new law went into effect on July 1, 2012, requiring that all public and private K-12 schools and community colleges have an Integrated Pest Management (IPM) Plan in place, a designated IPM Coordinator, and a list of acceptable low-impact pesticides to deal with things such as insects, rodents, invasive plant species, fungi, and other forms of plant and animal life that may infest or be detrimental to vegetation, humans, animals, or structures. The law heavily favors nonchemical means for dealing with pests, and requires schools to notify staff, students, and parents in advance if they need to apply any pesticide on school or District grounds. Each school and District building has a posted Integrated Pest Management notice that will be updated with planned pesticide applications as needed. This information is also posted on our website under [District/Integrated Pest Management](#). People who have chemical sensitivities or medical conditions that could be aggravated by proximity to chemicals/chemical fumes are encouraged to check the posted notice and website frequently for up-to-date information.
