District News: Superintendent Listening Session Reminder. Superintendent Mike Scott will hold his first Listening Session of the 2012-13 school year on Tuesday, October 16, from 7:00 to 8:30 p.m. in the commons at Evergreen Middle School (29850 NW Evergreen Road). Mr. Scott will talk about Hillsboro's accountability under the new achievement compact system, our structure for reporting student data, our strategic priority of addressing the achievement gap, and more. He will also take questions from the audience. Spanish translation will be provided.

Free Cardiac Screenings. The most common cause of sudden cardiac arrest in young people is hypertrophic cardiomyopathy, or HCM, an inherited disease that affects 1 in 500. More than half of youth who have HCM have no symptoms. So if you have a history of heart disease in your family or simply want some peace of mind before your child starts playing sports or getting involved in other strenuous activities, you may want to take advantage of Providence Heart and Vascular Institute's Play Smart™ heart screenings. The screenings are offered free of charge to youth ages 12-18 and include a heart health questionnaire, blood pressure measurement, electrocardiogram, echocardiogram (if needed), cardiologists to explain test results, as well as resources to learn more about sudden cardiac arrest and heart disease prevention. Advance appointments are required and donations are appreciated to ensure the program can continue. For more information, visit the PlaySmart website.
