**District News: Dr. Rudy Crew Town Hall Reminder.** Don't forget that Oregon's Chief Education Officer, Dr. Rudy Crew, will be holding a public Town Hall event in the Liberty High School auditorium (21945 NW Wagon Way, Hillsboro) this Wednesday, October 10, from 6:30-8:00 p.m. Dr. Crew is visiting communities around the state to share his vision for education and talk with constituents about their questions, concerns, hopes and expectations for our students. This is Dr. Crew's only Washington County stop, so please attend if you are able!

**OEIB Funding Forums.** The Oregon Education Investment Board (OEIB) is a group of 12 educators and community leaders who were named by the Governor to oversee the effort to create a seamless, unified system for investing in and delivering public education from early childhood through high school and college. One of their five main goals, as outlined by Senate Bill 909 (2011), is to develop an education investment strategy to improved defined learning outcomes for students at all levels of the system. To that end, they are holding a series of community forums where citizens can provide input and feedback on education funding. The closest one to us will be held on Thursday, October 18, in the Marshall High School Auditorium (3905 91st Ave., Portland, 97266) from 6:00-8:00 p.m. The venue will offer a family-friendly area for parents with children, as well as light snacks and refreshments. Spanish translation will be provided. Anyone wishing to speak must sign in beginning at 5:30 p.m. Individuals will be heard on a first come basis and will be given two minutes each. Public comment may also be e-mailed to [education.investment@state.or.us](mailto:education.investment@state.or.us). If you can't make the meeting on the 18th, there will also be a webinar held on Monday, October 29, from 3:00-5:00 p.m. streaming at <http://www.ode.state.or.us/search/page/?id=3310>.
