District News: Community Project at Hare Field Needs Your Help! For the past six years, Ed Oster—the District’s Nutrition Services Warehouse Manager—has been working on a project to replace and expand the concession stand at the east end of the Hare Field track. The project isn’t one Ed was asked to do as part of his job, but rather one he wanted to do to help out sports and activity groups from Hilhi, Glencoe, and the broader Hillsboro community. So he’s personally been fundraising, calling in favors, and coordinating contractors and volunteers to chip away at the project ever since. More than just a concession stand, the 1,600 square foot structure will feature a mini locker room with a bathroom and shower where sports officials can change and prepare for games, and a storage area where coaches and advisors can store equipment, as well as a covered outdoor barbecue area. The structure was initially designed by students in Don Domes’ Architectural Drafting class at Hilhi. Their drawings were then sent to local architectural firm Partin & Hill for review and tweaking before being sent to a civil engineer for final specifications—all design work was donated. Six years ago, when the design was finalized, the estimate for the structure was \$65,000-\$85,000. Ed has raised about \$20,000 so far, but has been able to get about half the work completed because of so many community partners donating or discounting their products and/or services. So he needs another \$30,000-\$40,000 to finish the project. The structure is ready to be framed, and the hope is that he can have the stand completed in time for spring track meets.
