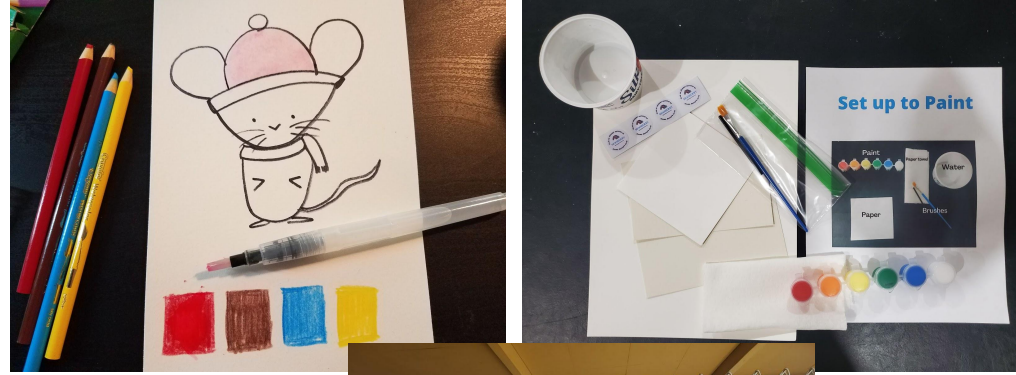
# ART IN THE PANDEMIC
