Child Find

The Hillsboro School District has an obligation to locate, identify, and evaluate all students who live within the Hillsboro School District boundaries or attends a private school within the Hillsboro School District boundaries.

Residency and Service Location

For students who are parentally placed in private school, it is the responsibility of the district where the private school is located to evaluate the student for a disability and offer an Individual Services Plan (ISP).

Funding

Funding for parentally placed private school services is based off available IDEA funds, not state funds.

The funds available to provide services to parentally placed private schools totals, \$17,166.97 or \$1,072.94 per student.

Available Services

Transportation

The use of transportation to provide access to services would exhaust all the available funds for services without the provision of any services.

Cost of transportation \$7.74 per hour

Service Options:

Each parentally placed student is entitled to 900 services minutes of either speech language, reading, writing, and math or a combinations of services. 900 service minutes divided by 10 months is equivalent to 90 service minutes a month for the entire school year.

ISP vs. IEP

An Individual Services Plan (ISP) is not the same as an Individual Education Plan (IEP).

An ISP only provides the amount of service that is determined to be made available to parentally placed private school students. The service is not based on all the services the student may need.

An IEP provides all the services a student may require to access their education.

Location of Services

Services will be provided at their neighborhood school if the student reside within HSD boundaries. Out of District students will receive services at the school that is closest to the private school.

If there are no transportation services selected, it is the parent's responsibility to transport the student to the public school to receive services.

Case Managers will work with families to determine when services will be provided.

Insufficient funds

In the event there are insufficient funds to provide the services on an ISP, the district would reduce services by 30 minutes.

An IEP meeting would be held between HSD staff, private school staff, and the family.

Resolving issues

If there is a concern, the private school will contact an HSD Director of Student Services to determine if there is a potential resolution to the concern.
