

HSD School Dance Rules

1. All school rules will be enforced at dances (e.g. no tobacco, weapons, drug and alcohol). Any Class A or Class B offense will be dealt with accordingly. (See Parent/Student Handbook). Any student who engages in fighting, harassment, or other disruptive behavior shall be immediately dealt with accordingly by the administrator on duty. Ticket price will not be refunded if a student is asked to leave the dance.
2. Non-students of the host school must have a signed and approved guest pass. Students may only bring one outside guest. Guests may not be in middle school nor may they be 21 or over (20 yr old max).
3. All students and guests must have valid picture ID to be admitted to the dance.
4. Appropriate dress and shoes should be worn at all times. See HSD Standards of Student Conduct.
5. Students must remain inside. Doors may be opened under the supervision of a chaperone to promote air circulation, but students must stay within the building. If there is a problem, all doors will remain permanently closed during the event.
6. In order to maintain a safe and fun environment, appropriate physical contact is expected at the dance. If any behavior looks questionable, students will be addressed and behavior will need to stop.
7. Any student leaving the dance may not re-enter.
8. Backpacks are not allowed at the event - coats should be checked.
9. Outside food and beverages are not allowed at the event.
10. All students and guests must leave location within 20 minutes of the end of function. No loitering in parking lots. Parents/guardians please pick up your student within this time limit.
