ACTIVITIES REPORT- SCOTT THOMAS

- Coin Food Drive was successful! Partnered with Elks to provide food and gifts in Hillsboro school district. With Century's help the community raised almost \$12k.
- To be rescheduled (originally Jan 19): Incentive Award Ceremony, where students can be nominated for having completed a lot of service hours, will be granted a ticket to Winter Formal, have a luncheon, and teachers may do some challenges like ice bucket or dyed hair.
- Week of Jan 22: Winter Week. On the 20th the Commons will be decorated. Theme for Winter formal is "Northern Lights". There will be dress up days that week. Cereal bar on Wednesday. Dance is 27th from 8pm-11pm. Grad night will be selling drinks and treats. Tickets for the Formal are on sale now. Guest passes are also available, which take 5-6 days to turn around. Would love volunteers to help with entrance areas, such as coat check. Volunteers needed 7:15pm-11:15pm.

ATHLETICS REPORT- MICHELLE GRAY

- Basketball nights are 6 games per night, 2 at a time, starting 4:15 with the first game, and last game starting at 7:15.
- Feb 9 and Feb 10: We will be hosting the Girls Regional Wrestling Event. There will be lots of people from many different schools. Century has 15 girls from our school. Winners of this event go to State. Event will be during the school day, starting around 8:30 or 9am, and last about 4 hours. Afterwards, we will get set up for basketball that night. Volunteers needed.
- Jan 18: Senior Night, last wrestling event. Great event for Boosters to sell gear at. First event starts at 5pm, and we have 2 schools competing with us.
 - Typical wrestling events have JV start at 6pm and Varsity start at 7pm. Girls wrestling is included if the other school has enough to wrestle. Some nights have 2 competitor schools like on Senior Night, and for those nights, the game starts at 5pm.
- Spring sports registration opens in 2 weeks, and will start Mon Feb 26.

PRINCIPAL REPORT- JULIE KASPER

- Teachers are updating links/slides/videos about their offered classes by end of next week. These will be available to students so they may select classes for next year. Students will go through this process over 3 weeks after Feb 19. Classes with minimal sign ups may not be offered. After Spring Break, we will know which classes will be offered based on course requests and staffing.

- In ELA, our teachers are doing Inquiry by Design curriculum, which includes sustained silent reading, which has helped improve book checkouts from the school media center.
- In Math, we've found that more career paths lean on Data Science types of math rather than Pre-Calc and Calculus, so we are exploring adding different Math paths at the school in future years.
- Northwest Cafe is offering an opportunity for students to showcase their wins and challenges, and it's an opportunity for the students to win a scholarship.
- At the Jan 23 school board meeting, the vote will be held to determine if the next 2 school years will start before labor day.
- Feb 1 is the end of this semester.
- State testing for Juniors is coming up in April.

- We are considering hosting a community garage sale in the school parking lot this spring/summer to help raise funds. We are in discussion with the Grad Night Committee to possibly combine it with their annual Car Show.
