ACTIVITIES REPORT- SCOTT THOMAS

- Amazing start to the school year, feels “normal” and students appear excited
- Senior Sunrise, current seniors meet on the field to watch the sunrise on their last first day of school, was well attended.
- Students were pumped up at the welcoming assembly, all students were able to be together in the gym and had performances from the dance team, cheer team, and other groups.
- Club Rush will have a different set up this year. Clubs and Activities will be set up in the gym. Will have an extended period, with half the students visiting during the beginning and the other half at the end.
- In the past have had over 20 clubs, this year have about 16

 - 10/15 Homecoming dance

ATHLETICS REPORT-

- New Athletics Director, Michelle Gray, unable to attend due to sport competitions, Volleyball and the soccer match against Westview. Both soccer teams, Century and Westview, are undefeated. Expecting a great turn out
- Some home games will be held at the stadium to provide sufficient seating to accommodate large crowds. Also for safety and security. Will continue to use both facilities going forward
- Some sport competitions are being bumped or rescheduled. This is due to a statewide referee shortage.

PRINCIPAL REPORT- JULIE KASPER

- Jag crew was present for the Freshman’s first day, for some of the upperclassmen, this was a new experience
- Reminder about the importance of attendance and being on time to classes. Tardy sweeps will begin this week and detentions will be in place this year.
- Hired some new staff, Spanish teacher, SPED case manager, and other positions.
- Approximately 65-75 students over projections, Century was provided with additional 2.0 FTE, which was added just last week. Will be able to use that to offer additional electives, some students may have schedule changes over the next two weeks. Schedule changes will mostly be limited to students who did not get their first choice electives.
- Changes this year for turning in late assignments, will now be due at the end of quarter. Students will have two weeks, from the test date, to make up/retake tests

- Grading policy- See the class syllabi for teacher specific policies
 - All teachers are using 0-4 scale
 - Summative should be weighted more than formative
 - Parents can request to join Google classrooms to stay informed of assignments and missing work. Also can be seen in ParentVUE.
- Counselors - Join the Class of 20__ Google classrooms to be informed of grade level specific topics and resources
- Made adjustments to counselor caseloads to even out workload. This year is a trial basis and will make adjustments if needed.
- PTC will be the Monday and Tuesday, week of Thanksgiving. Request for input: what did/didn't work from last year, preference for in-person or online.
 - Parent comments: split 50/50 for in-person vs. online, Liked the appointment option when online, didn't have to stand in line. Some parents prefer the in-person interaction
- 65% of current seniors are on track to graduate, which has usually been above 90% in the past. Will continue with Pass Plans to help students get on track and have the opportunity to graduate on time.
- Grad coaches are working with students to make graduation plans
- Four year completer rate is lower than the five year completer rate.
