ATHLETICS REPORT- MICHELLE GRAY

- Michelle was able to join the meeting virtually, shared her goal is to increase number of students participating in sports
- In the middle of winter sports season
 - Basketball starting double headers, added 4th Boys team
 - Wrestling- getting ready to host the girls' region 1 tournament, 2/3 and 2/4
 - Swimming- HSD about 35 members and hosted their first home meet on 1/19
 - Dance- Has several weekend competitions coming up
 - Cheer - has been at many of the home sporting events, have 18 on the team

- Sophomores will begin Comprehensive Sex Ed lessons in March, parents will receive additional information

- Counselors are wrapping up prepping for forecasting for next year classes, will meet in February with grade levels to provide forecasting info to students

- On track to graduate rate is improving
- Calendar for 23-24, not been finalized by board yet
 - 1614 families and 955 staff completed the calendar survey
 - 23% voted to start school after Labor day, only 1.7% voted to start before Labor day
 - Received requests for more background info and explanations about calendar survey and impacts of responses
