Activities Director Report- MR. SCOTT THOMAS

- Finished Winter Spirit week
- Clubs will be selling roses and candies for Valentine's Day.

ATHLETICS REPORT- MR. JEREMY CORWIN

- Wrestling tournament held at CHS and great turnout with 38 schools and over 175 wrestlers. Spectator limit 1 spectator per participant
- Temporary spectator limit continues - HSD sent out an email by mistake that limits were lifted.
- Swim team won against Forest Grove
- Spring season starts Feb. 28, get registrations in early
- Hired 2 new golf coaches
- Thankful for the kindness of the community with the spectator limits.
- Facilities is looking at installing a permanent fence around the softball field
- Mr. Corwin is looking for feedback on what the future (next 2 to 3 years) of the Athletics program should look like:
 - Covered area for the bleachers
 - Keep uniforms up to date for all sports
 - Not having the need to do as much fundraising as they currently do. This takes away from the intention to have fun with sports.
 - Increase in transparency of financials, opportunities to reach out to community organizations for sponsorship
 - Improve concession area- so not standing in mud when it rains
 - Area for Booster clubs to set up at games (other than under the bleachers)
