ATHLETICS REPORT- JEREMY CORWIN

- Winter sports ended, Scott Kellar won the Pacific Coach of the year award
- Dance coach nominated for 6A Coach of the year award
- 24 students received all league recognition
- Boys basketball made it to first round of finals
- 8 boys wrestled at state, 3 placed and 3 girls wrestled at state, 1 placed
- 242 registered for Spring sports, 101 track , 55 tennis, 8 golf, 40 baseball, 13 softball
