Principal Report- Roger Will Supporting Principal

- Return to school plans
 - LIPI began last week at the Elementary level and will continue to expand next week to other grade levels.
 - Approximately 20 seniors will participate at Century. Focused on the most at risk seniors when recruiting and the students voluntarily agreed to attend LIPI
 - Staff also volunteered to teach in LIPI
 - Meet for 2 hours, 2 days a week
 - Safety protocols and plans in place to keep students and staff as safe as possible
 - The HSD goal is to have students return to in person learning by mid April. Pending safety guidelines set forth by the state
- AP Testing
 - Possible in person testing if not able to test in person then there will be a distance/online format
- PSAT Testing
 - January 26 for Juniors, 45 signed up and will test at Century
 - Plans are set, classrooms, bathrooms, one way entry/exits, etc.
 - Schools can only host the PSAT 1 time a year which is why it was moved from October to January for this school year
